Road Maintenance

Working with our team of operators, you will

- Perform preventive and operational maintenance on all Town-maintained roads including cold patching, gravel resurfacing, dust control, shouldering and gravel retrieval.
- Perform road construction including excavation, hauling gravel, base repair, signage, locates, traffic control, pavement preparation.
- Maintain ditches and sidewalks including mowing, brushing, rehabilitation, driveway, and culverts.

Winter Operations

- Perform winter maintenance including snow clearing, ice blading, winging back snow on Town roads and clearing Town parking lots, trucking away excess snow, blending of salt and sand, and documentation of usage of recommended materials.

Facility Maintenance

- Assist with the maintenance and ongoing operations, mainly set-up and tear down for special events and rentals.
- Ensure parks amenities and facilities are safe, clean and operational to encourage maximum use.
- Perform minor facility and equipment maintenance, as needed.

What it Takes to do the Job

To excel in this role, you should possess:

- Minimum Ontario Secondary School Diploma, or equivalent.
- Valid Class 'G' Driver's License.
- 3-5 years general construction and/or maintenance experience
- Preference will be given to candidates with a licensed or unlicensed trade (Mechanic, HVAC, plumber, mason, electrician, roofing, painting, welding, millwright, etc)

WHMIS, First Aid & CPR, Valid DZ/AZ license would be an asset.
