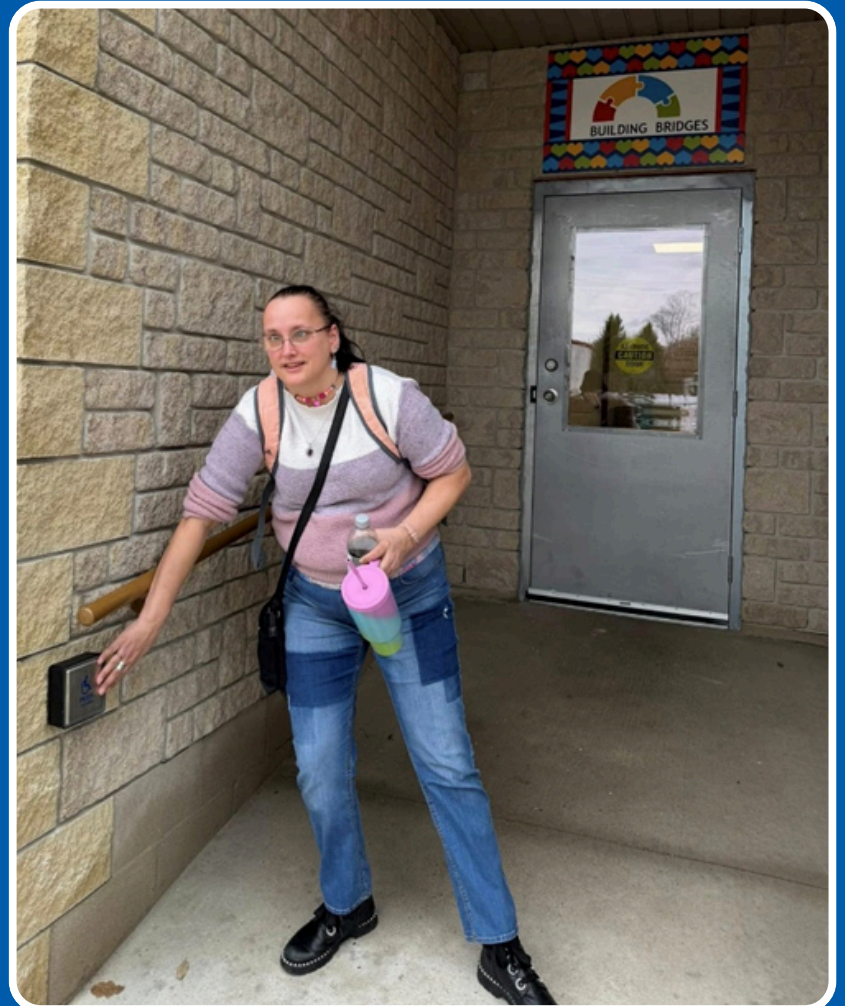
OPENING DOORS TO ACCESSIBILITY

Accessibility improvements at this downtown Palmerston building are helping make local businesses more welcoming and inclusive for everyone.

With support from the Town of Minto Community Improvement Structural Grant, the property owner installed an automatic door button and a compatible commercial door, removing barriers and improving access for customers, clients, and staff.

This project was informed by the Town of Minto's downtown accessibility audits, completed with local businesses in the fall of 2025. The audits identified practical, achievable upgrades that could improve accessibility and usability in downtown spaces, helping guide investments like this one.
