Children at Play Signage POLICY

The Ontario Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, particularly Section 224(a) states that one of the roles of Council is to develop and evaluate the policies and programs of the municipality. Therefore the Council of the Town of Minto considers it to be in the public interest to enact a Policy entitled Children at Play signage for Town of Minto residents.

The employees of the Town of Minto Public Works Department receive several requests for *Children at Play* signage from Town of Minto residents. Therefore, the purpose of this Policy is to give direction to staff with the information when residents request *Children at Play* signage.

A written request from the Town of Minto resident must be submitted to the Town of Minto Public Service Superintendent for the approval of *Children at Play* signage to be erected along the road allowance in the appropriate area. Once the Director of Public Services has approved the request for the *Children at Play* signage; the appropriate signage shall be ordered by the municipality only after payment (approximately \$50 for the sign and approximately \$50 for the post and the cost of the installation) has been received from the resident for the *Children at Play* signage. When the signage has been received by the municipality; the Public Works Department shall erect the signage on a sign post along the road allowance in the appropriate area.
